Annual returns (ITRs) should also be attached for last three Financial Years i.e. 2012-13, 2013-14 & 2014-15. - 7.1.2 The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, Forms, Terms and conditions in the Tender document. Failure to furnish all information required by the Tender document or submission of a tender not substantially responsive to the Tender document in every respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of his bid.
- 7.1.3 The bidder shall not make or cause to be made any alteration, erasure or obliteration to the text of the tender document.

- 8.3.3 The rates quoted by the Bidder shall be as per Annexure VIII.
- 8.3.4 The bidder while quoting rate shall take into account the minimum manpower mentioned in terms and conditions of the tender document.
- 8.3.5 The rate quoted shall be responsive and the same should be inclusive of all statutory obligations such as Minimum Wages as approved by the Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak from time to time, ESI, EPF contributions, service charges, all kinds of taxes etc. The offers of those prospective bidders which do not meet the statutory requirements are liable to be rejected.
- 8.3.6 Conditional bids/ offers will be summarily rejected.

- 8.6 <u>Duration of Contract:</u> The contract shall be valid for two years (initially valid for one year and extendable for another one year subject to satisfactory services), however in breach of any terms and conditions of the contract, the contract shall be terminated summarily at any time and performance security will be forfeited.
- 8.7 **Bid Security: -**
- 8.7.1 The contractor shall deposit Bid Security i.e. Earnest Money Deposit(EMD) for an amount of Rs.11 Lacs (Rupees Eleven lacs only) in the form of an Fixed Deposit Receipt from a commercial bank in an acceptable form in favor of the Registrar, UHS, Rohtak along with the Tender document. The Bid Security shall remain valid for a period of forty five days beyond the final bid validity period of (180 days).
- 8.7.2 Any tender not accompanied by Bid Security shall be rejected.
- 8.7.3 Bid Securities of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at the earliest after expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before the 30th day after the award of the contract.
- 8.7.4 Bid Security of the successful bidder shall be returned on receipt of Performance Security/ Bank Guarantee in the Department and after signing the contract agreement.
- 8.7.5 Bid Security shall be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or modifies his bid (unless with consent of UHS) during the period of Tender validity.
- 8.7.6 Bid Security shall be forfeited if the successful bidder refuses or neglects to execute the Contract or fails to furnish the required Performance Security/ Bank Guarantee within the time as specified by the Department
- 8.8 Format and Signing of Bid:
- 8.8.1 The bidder shall submit one copy of the Tender document and addenda, if any thereto, with each page of this document signed and stamped to confirm the acceptance of the terms & conditions of the tender by the bidder.
- 8.8.2 The documents comprising the bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and all pages of the bid shall be signed by a person or persons duly authorized to sign on behalf of the

- bidder. All pages of the bid, where entries or amendments have been made, shall be signed by the person or persons signing the bid.
- 8.8.3 The bid shall contain no alterations, omissions or additions except those to comply with instruction issued by the Department, or are necessary or correct errors made by the bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed/signed and dated by the person or persons signing the bid.

9. **Submission of Bids:** -

- 9.1.5 The tender shall remain valid and open for acceptance for a period of 6 months from the last date of submission of tender.

9.2 Late and Delayed Tenders: -

- 9.2.1 Bids must be received in the Department at the address specified above not later than the date and time as stipulated in the NIT. The UHS, Rohtak may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for submission of bids in which case all rights and obligations of the UHS, Rohtak and the Bidder will be the same.
- 9.2.2 Any bid received by the Department after the deadline for submission of bids, as stipulated above, shall not be considered.

10.1 **Bid Opening and Evaluation:** -

- 10.1.1 The authorized representatives of the UHS will open the Technical Bids in the presence of the Bidders or their representatives who may choose to attend at the appointed place, date and time.
- 10.1.2 The bid of any bidder who does not meet the eligibility criteria and / or has not complied with one or more of the conditions prescribed in the terms & conditions will be summarily rejected. Technical evaluation of only eligible bids shall be carried out.

terminate the contract. In such an eventuality, earnest money deposited shall stand forfeited

- 10.2.4 ESI Account to be opened at Rohtak with in a month.
- 10.2.5 EPF Accounts to be opened at Rohtak and amount deposited accordingly with in a month.
- 10.2.6 Bank accounts to be opened at SBI, Medical College, Rohtak.
- 11.1 Award of Contract: -
- 11.1.1 The UHS, Rohtak will award the contract to the successful evaluated bidder whose bid has been found to be responsive and who is eligible and qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily as per the terms and conditions incorporated in the bidding document.
- 11.1.2 The authorities will communicate the successful bidder by facsimile confirmed by letter transmitted by Registered post that his bid has been accepted. This letter (hereinafter and in the condition of contract called the "Letter of Award") shall prescribe the amount which Department will pay to the contractor in consideration of the execution of work/services by the contractor as prescribed in the contract.
- 11.1.3 The successful bidder will be required to execute an agreement in the form specified in Annexure VI within a period of 03 weeks from the date of issue of Letter of Award but before the work is taken up for execution.
- 11.1.4 The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance Security/Bank Guarantee within 03 weeks of issue of 'Letter of Award' for an amount equal to 10% (**Ten Percent**) of the estimated total cost of the contract for two years, in the form Fixed Deposit Receipt from a commercial bank, or Bank Guarantee from a commercial bank in an acceptable form (Annexure –VII) in favor of the Registrar, UHS, Rohtak. The Performance Security/Bank Guarantee shall remain valid for a period of sixty days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations. In case the contract period is extended further, the validity of Performance Security shall also be extended by the contractor accordingly.
- 11.1.5 Failure of the successful bidder to comply with the requirements of above clauses shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of Bid Security.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SANITATION SERVICES CONTRACT

- 1. The contract shall be valid initially for two years from the commencement of the contract but to be reviewed after completion of one year period and to be extended for second year subject to satisfactory services only.
- 2. The staff engaged by the service provider shall be available at all the times as per their duty roster and shall provide a copy of the same to the O/o Medical Supdt. and they shall not leave their place of duty during duty hours on any pretext without the prior permission of the Nodal Officer/authorized officer at the respective area of the UHS, Rohtak. Round the clock supervision must be provided to ensure correct performance of the sanitation services in accordance with the prevailing assignment / instructions agreed upon between the two parties.
- 3. The service provider shall be responsible to provide immediate replacement of any staff who is not available for duty at the place of posting.
- 4. As per guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, no person will be allowed smoking in public place by the workers of the service provider. The service provider will be responsible, if any, workers provided by him are found smoking in the Institute and he will be penalized in accordance with the rules.
- 5. Biometric system should be installed by the contractor at its own cost for daily attendance in three shifts and details should be sent by email after half an hour of the commencement of each shift followed by hard copy submitted during the course of the day. The bills will not be processed unless it is accompanied by attendance generated by biometric system. However the competent authorities reserve the right to relax this condition at any point of time during the contract.

6. Sanitation Control Room:-

The company/ agency shall employ & post "Sanitation Control Room" round the clock in each shift, experienced in the field of sanitation work at the Hospital premises at its own cost for taking care of queries/matters relating to sanitation work and matters relating to the company and its employees and also for immediate interaction with the hospital authorities. The agency will have to maintain the telephone no. mobile, no., names of persons manning the control room in their office for any urgent communication regarding any extra-ordinary situation.

7. Complaints redress:-

The supervisors of specific blocks/areas/floors shall interact with the incharge's of respective area/ blocks/floors for regular interaction on weekly basis. They shall take complaints and redress the same as may be raised in meetings.

8. **Penal Provisions:-**

- (a) In case the service provider fails to commence the work as stipulated in the agreement, the authorities reserve the right to impose and recover penalty as detailed below:-
- (i) 2% (two percent) of cost of order/agreement per week up to Two weeks delays in commencement of work.
- (ii) After two weeks delay as mentioned above, the authorities may cancel the agreement and get this job carried out preferably from any other agency from the open market/ other bidder. The difference in cost, if any, will be recovered from the defaulting service provider as damages and he may be black listed for a period of four years from participating in such types of tenders and his security deposit shall also be forfeited, if so warranted.
- (b) In case any personnel deployed under the contract is (are) absent, suitable replacement has to be provided immediately, otherwise a penalty of Rs.300/- per person on that particular day may be deducted by the UHS, Rohtak as deemed fit from the service provider's bills.
- (c) In case any of service provider's personnel deployed under the contract fails to report in time and service provider is unable to provide suitable substitute in time for the same it will be treated as absence and penalty as mentioned in point 8(b) above may be imposed as deemed fit by the UHS, Rohtak.
- (d) The personnel engaged by the service provider should turn out dressed in neat and clean uniform (including proper name badges) failing which the agency may invites a penalty of Rs.200/- per person on each occasions and habitual offenders in this regard shall be removed from work at the UHS, Rohtak. The penalty on this account shall be deducted from the service provider's bills.
 - (e) In case any public complaint received attributable to misconduct/ misbehavior/ drunken state of service provider's personnel and as verified by the competent

- authority, a penalty of Rs.500/- for each such incident may be levied and the same shall be deducted from service provider's bill. Further, the concerned guilty person shall be withdrawn by the service provider. Besides legal action as required under relevant rules/ acts be also initiated against the guilty persons by the service provider.
- (f) The Manpower engaged by the service provider for sanitation services shall not take part in any labour union or association activities. In case of strike by a group of workers fine of Rs.25,000/- for 1st instance, Rs.50,000/- for 2nd instance and Rs.75,000/- for 3rd instance and onward will be imposed.
- (g) If the contractor services were not found satisfactory, the contractor may be penalized the amount of Rs.2000/- to Rs.10,000/- at each occasion. However, in spite of repeated penalties, if services are not improved then the authority will be at liberty to terminate the contract after issuing show cause notice & till maturity of subsequent contract the continuation will be got done at the risk and cost of the contractor recoverable from his security / bank guarantee.
- (h) The competent authority for imposing the penalty shall be the Vice-Chancellor, Pro Vice-Chancellor, Registrar, Director and Medical Superintendent. However, it is clarified that the Vice Chancellor of UHS, Rohtak reserve the right to relax or exempt any penal provision given in the point No 8 (a to g).
- 9. There shall be 8 hours shift duty in general.
- 10. The service provider shall issue EPF statement and ESI card to every worker and shall supply the Code Number allotted by the local ESI/ EPF authorities. In case of violation a suitable penalty may be imposed by the UHS, Rohtak.
- 11. The department will not be liable to the payment of compensation to any staff so deployed by the contractor (firm/company/person) on duty for any accident or health hazards suffered while working in the institute. This institution will not have any relation as master and servant with persons deployed by the contractor (firm/company/person).
- 12. The competent authority as mentioned in point 8 (h) above shall have the right, within reason, to have any person removed, who is considered to be undesirable or otherwise and similarly service provider reserve the right to change the staff with intimation to the concerned authorities immediately.
- 13. The Service provider shall submit an undertaking of verification of character antecedent of staff employed by him within 2 month to the authorities.
- 14. The service provider will maintain a register on which day to day deployment of personnel will be entered. While raising the bill, the deployment particulars of the personnel engaged during each month, shift wise, should be certified by the authorized officials of UHS, Rohtak.

Payment Related Clauses:-

- 15. The service provider shall have to pay wages to its workers latest by 7th of respective month before submitting the claim for re-imbursement as per this contract agreement. The service provider shall submit the bill with the concerned officer for re-imbursement of the same by 10th of every month. In case the bill is not processed in time the competent authorities of UHS, Rohtak reserves the right to release the wages part of the bill and other part of bill will be reimbursed after proper verification.
- 16. The payment will be released after the deduction of any penalty, if any, imposed by the competent authority as per contract agreement.
- 17. The service provider will make the payment/ credits the salaries in the ADHAR linked bank account of his outsource employees. The service provider shall provide an undertaking regarding the compliance of same along with the bills. However, the competent authorities of UHS, Rohtak reserve the right to relax this clause.
- 18. The Income Tax or any other statutory levy/tax as applicable will be payable by service provider and shall be deducted at source as per law.
 - The contractor would be required to fulfil the terms and conditions of the provision of EPF & Misc. Provision Act 1952 and employees provident Fund Scheme 1952 in respect of labourers/employees engaged by him for performing the works. Each bill claim of the contractor should accompany the following information:-
- 19. List showing the detail of labourers/employees engaged along with the Aadhaar Number/EID Number. In case any labourer/employee is not having the Aadhaar Number/EID Number the same should be got enrolled at the nearest Enrolment centre. In exceptional cases where neither Aadhaar Number nor EID number can be made available, other details like bank account may be submitted.
- 20. Duration of their engagement.
- 21. The amount paid to labourers/employees for the duration in question. Payment should be

- made either through NEFT/Aadhaar Payment Bridge (APB), Authenticated documents of payments should be attached.
- 22. Amount of EPF contribution (both employer & employees contribution) for duration of engagement in question, paid to the EPF authorities.
- 23. Copies of authenticated documents of payment of such contribution to EPF authorities. The complete details of the UAN number of the employee, other details along with the amount transferred should be submitted.
- 24. Declaration from the contractor regarding compliance of conditions of EPF Act-1952, Labour laws & ESI Act.
- 25. Any liabilities arising out of any litigation (including those in consumer courts) due to any act of service provider's personnel shall be directly borne by the service provider including all compensation/ damage/ expenses/ fines/ deaths of personnel while on duty. The concerned service provider personnel shall attend the court as and when required.
- 26. The UHS, Rohtak does not recognize any employer-employee with any of the workers of the service provider. The contract worker is the employee of the service provider and can in no way claim any right for regularization of service with the institute.
- 27. The service providing agency should not employ any person below the age of 18 years and above the age of 50 years. However, the competent authorities of UHS, Rohtak reserve the right to relax this clause at any time during the contract.
- 28. The contractor will provide 20% female staff.
- 29. The Courts at Rohtak shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to try all disputes, if any arising out of this agreement between the parties.
- 30. The service provider shall not hire personnel with dubious/criminal records.
- 31. The UHS, Rohtak shall not be responsible for providing residential accommodation to any of the personnel of the service provider.
- 32. The service provider shall not engage any sub-contract or transfer the contract to any other person in any matter except the specialized work of pest/ rodent control from the persons/ firms specialized in this work, however the institute shall not make any extra payment except agreed in the price bid.
- 33. The service Provider shall provide a help desk for providing the details of ESI & EPF contributions to their employees. The contractor shall submit an affidavit to the effect that he has deposited the ESI & EPF contribution of all employees as per the statutory provisions along with the submissions of bills.
- 34. The Vice Chancellor, UHS, Rohtak reserve the right to increase or decrease or withdraws the number of sanitation services under this tender. Further the Vice Chancellor reserves the right to increase or decrease the scope of sanitation services under this contract.
- 35. Vice Chancellor, UHS, Rohtak reserves the right to withdraw this tender at any time and at any stage without assigning any reason.
- 36. Contractor(firm/company/person) shall provide to the Safai-Karamchari sufficient number of soft/hard brooms / brushes, Lyzol, Phenyl, Finit (ISI marked/superior quality) cleaning powder (ISI marked/superior quality) Commercial Acid, floor duster, polythene bags or any such material required for proper sanitation at his own cost. The above material shall be got approved from the institute authorities. The cost of said material may be included in rates to be quoted by the contractor (firm/company/person) in the tender forms accordingly which will be paid by this institute as per competitive rate quoted in the tender form.
- 37. Rodent and pest control measures etc. may be undertaken regularly in the UHS, Rohtak complex atleast once a month or earlier, as per requirement provided that the contractor(firm/company/person) shall be responsible for the reimbursement of any loss/losses towards the repair of any medical equipment etc. due to his negligence while providing pest control services etc. The contractor (firm/company/person) shall also give a certificate to this effect every month. Contractor (firm/company/person) shall arrange anti rodent medicines (Rat Killers) and other such material etc. at his own cost. It is emphasized that the service provider shall ensure pest free (including rodents) premises failing which service provider shall be liable for imposing penalty as deemed fit by the authorities. The service provider may get this work done from the persons/ firms specialized in this work, however the institute shall not make any extra payment except agreed in the price bid.
- 38. Any lapse in observing the Bio-Medical Waste Management rules leading to penalty if any will be the responsibility of the contractor (firm/company/person).
- 39. **Licenses:** Wherever relevant, before commencing the Work/Service the successful Tenderer shall be required to produce to the satisfaction, of the UHS, Rohtak a valid Contract Labour License (if employing labour) issued in its favour under the provision of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition), Act 1970. On failure to do so, the

acceptance of the Tender is liable to be withdrawn and also the Earnest Money is liable to be forfeited.

Force Majeure: - If at any time during the period of the contract, either party is subject to force majeure, which can be termed as natural disasters or, acts of God etc. which may prevent either party to discharge its obligation, the affected party shall promptly notify the other party about the happening of such an event. Neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate the contract in respect of such performance of their obligations. The obligations under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after the event has come to an end or ceased to exist. If the performance of any obligation under the contract is prevented or delayed by reason of the event beyond a period mutually agreed to if any or 21 days, whichever is more, either party may at its option terminate the contract.

Dispute Resolution: -

- a) Any dispute and or difference arising out of or relating to this contract will be resolved through joint discussion of the authorized representatives of the concerned parties. However, if the disputes are not resolved by joint discussions, then the matter will be referred for adjudication to a sole Arbitrator appointed by the Vice-Chancellor, Pt. B. D. Sharma, University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.
- b) The award of the sole Arbitrator shall be final and binding on all the parties. The arbitration proceeding's shall be governed by Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time.
- c) The cost of Arbitration shall be borne by the defaulter. During the pendency of the arbitration proceeding and currency of contract, neither party shall be entitled to suspend the work/service to which the dispute relates on account of the arbitration and payment to the Security Agency shall continue to be made in terms of the contract. Arbitration proceedings will be held at **Rohtak**.

Jurisdiction of Court: - The courts at Rohtak shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to try all disputes, if any, arising out of this agreement between the parties.

Note: a) It is clarified that Vice Chancellor, UHS, Rohtak reserve the right to relax or amend/modify any clause of this tender document at any time before/during & after the contract period without assigning any reason.

SCOPE OF SANITATION SERVICES:-

The intending bidders/ contractors/ tenderer are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders to the nature of the site. The nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risk, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or effect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. Submission of tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plants etc. will be used by him and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the executions of the work.

1. Cleaning Services: -

The main objective is to provide a high level of a neat, clean, hygienic and presentable look to the entire area to keep the surrounding dust free. The contractor and his management team will supervise the awarded work. The contractor has to ensure that the staffs deployed are dressed in neat and clean uniform approved by the Pt. B. D. Sharma, UHS, Rohtak. The Officials of Pt. B. D. Sharma, UHS, Rohtak reserve the right to monitor the entire work and staff of service provider.

2. Daily Services: -

Cleaning services should be provided round the clock on all days including holidays in the areas specified above, so that all areas are neat and clean all the time. Working hours should be adjusted in such a manner that cleaning work in the morning should be completed well before 8:00am in rooms where work will start at 9:00am. Contractor will arrange manpower for special VIP visits, if required and provide full support and cooperation during functions, seminars, conferences organized by the Institute. Sanitation staff has to do following activities for all of the university areas:

- Cleaning, scrubbing and disinfecting bathrooms, toilets, wash basins, sanitary fittings, floors etc. of all the areas including wards, ICUs, OT and all other departments at regular intervals on daily basis.
- Cleaning sweeping, mopping with disinfectant stair cases, cabins, lobbies, reception, pantries, kitchen, canteen, Corridors Ceilings, etc. at regular intervals on daily basis.
- Vacuum cleaning of all carpets and upholstered furniture.
- Cleaning and disinfecting kidney trays, urinals bed pans, sputum mugs, humidifiers, suction bottles and emptying urine and drain bags whenever required.
- Cleaning blood spills and others such as human excreta, urine, vomitus, sterile body fluids as & when required.
- Cleaning of dust bins, waste paper baskets, cobwebs etc. and disposing off all collected refuse on daily basis at regular intervals i.e. 3 times.
- The dust bins shall be washed and garbage bags need to be placed in all garbage bins to avoid stains and clear them when it is full time to time.
- Collect garbage in specified colour coded bags from all dust bins and garbage bins existing inside the premises and shall dispose at the designated area within the hospital.
- Refilling, replacing and emptying of sharp containers at all stations.
- Offering and assisting the patient with kidney tray, urinals, bed pans, sputum cups when required and disposing the contents in the sluice room, clean, disinfect and keep it ready for next use.
- Washing linen which are soiled by urine, vomitus, faeces and others with 1% hypochlorite solution and send to laundry.
- Spraying room fresheners in all rooms on daily basis at regular intervals.
- Washing of slippers in ICUs, OT, dialysis etc. Assist in fumigation of ICUs as per schedule.
- Cleaning and disinfecting all vitreous fixtures including toilet bowls, urinals, sinks, toilet Seats, containers etc. Brush thoroughly to include below water level and under rims including areas at hinges and cistern handles. Re-stock toiletries, which include liquid hand soap, toilet rolls, air fresheners, sanitary cubes, naphthalene balls in toilets, etc. after daily check -ups in the morning, afternoons and on call basis during daytime.
- Any additional work assigned by the ward I/C of the area where the sanitation staff has been placed on duty.

- Cleaning the patients who have soiled themselves with stool, urine, vomitus with assistance of Patient attendant / nursing orderly / staff nurse / nursing sister.
- **3. Weekly Services :-** The deep cleaning of the entire area will be done by the contractor once a week as under : -
- Thorough cleaning / sweeping / washing / mopping with disinfectant cleaning of all floors, staircases and toilets, scrubbing of all floors and ceramic tiles base.
- Cleaning of sanitary fitting, toilet drain pipes etc. in the toilets with standard cleaning material.
- Washing of outside area with High Pressure Jet Machine.
- The tenderer will make a cleaning program and submit to O/o Medical Superintendent, UHS, Rohtak for weekly cleaning so that concerned official / In-charge for the particular area can be deputed on the day of cleaning to make the area available and supervise the cleaning work.
- The contractor will work in the specified area mentioned in the scope of work.
- **4. Sanitation Monitoring and Control:-** For better management and smooth services, the following monitoring mechanism will be adopted by the contractor:-
 - **Toilets Checklist:-**This is to be attached on the back of the toilet door. It is to be filled up by the Contractor supervisor on duty daily.
 - Management/Housekeeping Services Requirements/ Complaints Report: This is to be filled up by the management and administrative staff of the Contractor who receive/observe the complaints/requirements for any of the Services. All suggestions, complaints related to services or staff deployed by the contractor will be registered at site and reported to O/o Medical Superintendent. The contractor will take immediate action to resolve the same failing which the Penalty Clause will be invoked.
 - Services Complaint Register: This register is to be completed on the basis of information received by the sanitary Supervisor from UHS, Rohtak officials through the inspection of the site, material on site, attendance sheet of the staff, weekly report, client letter/fax/e- mail, verbal complaints from competent authorities etc. and necessary action is to be taken.

• Additional Scope Pertaining to Hospital:-

Sanitation services in the hospital conditions are different than the sanitation services in other commercial organisations. Housekeeping staff has to work with the infected patients and has to handle dangerous infected materials and waste. Along with the routine housekeeping activities the housekeeping staffs has to show his / her humanitarian concern towards the patient and provide him/her all types of required help and services. Such services may be need based and might not been included in the general scope of work but they have to be provided by the housekeeping staff if needed. In view of the above, any work assigned by the sister I/C/Supervisor/Officers for the patient benefit like cleaning of vomits, urine, stool, blood or any undesired material produced by the ill patient or helping him/her in changing of soiled cloths/Linen or any type of need in emergency and helping the ill patient in any type of need is included in the scope of work. The housekeeping staff shall maintain cleanliness in the patient rooms/ ward throughout the day and shall clean the room thoroughly on patient's discharge and keep it ready for the next arrival.

The cleaning materials used by contractor should not be reactive to kota stone, vitrified tiles, ceramic tiles, mosaic flooring, carpets, furniture, upholstery, ceramic fittings of toilets, if it is found at any time that any damages occurred due to use of wrong chemicals the same shall be rectified on the risk and cost of contractor.

5. Cleaning of Laboratory and other Critical Areas:-

- All the dustbins shall be washed and lined with colour coded bags in the floor shall be thoroughly mopped with a specialized soap solution. The entire laboratory area shall be scrubbed at least twice in a week.
- Toilets/bathrooms shall be cleaned with soap solution and kept odour free using deodorizer cubes.
- The common areas shall be swept and mopped in the morning and at regular intervals to keep them clean.
- In morning the trash bag shall be changed when it is full.

6. The Contractor shall:

- Ensure Animal (quadrupeds), honey bee, bats, bees, pigeon, flies free environment in the premises of UHS, Rohtak.
- Ensure that their managers/supervisors are equipped with mobile phones.

- Provide Hospital Waste management services when applicable including all equipment, containers, trolleys etc.
- Arrange for a garbage disposal vehicle, and other equipment's required for segregation and disposal of waste in a professional manner to designated place as ear marked by the UHS, Rohtak.
- The contractor will also ensure that the garbage should be disposed separately i.e. dry and wet garbage in the marked disposal area in proper and eco-friendly manner.
- The contractor will arrange required resources, including manpower, machinery, disposables etc. which is used by the cleaning staff. The contractor will also ensure that the garbage collection / disposal work does not adversely affect the surroundings or personnel deputed for the work.
- The uniform provided to the workers should be different and distinguish from other categories of the Institute staff with name plate & badges.
- Every Supervisor deputed by the firm should maintain a register for keeping the daily record for sanitation services & should take signature from the concerned department for their comments.
- For any stolen, missing or defective items related to Civil, Electrical or A/C, persons in charge of outsourced facility of respective area shall lodge complaint with the concerned Engineering staff/section for getting the item replaced or repaired. Otherwise the responsibility lies with the outsourcing agency.
- The contractor shall depute optimum no of workers and supervisors including sufficient number of ladies workers (for ladies toilets and washrooms) for cleaning of the requisite toilets & corridors, lobby areas, including stair cases and lifts areas in UHS, Rohtak. The job will include cleaning and washing of urinals, W.C. pans, marble flooring, tiled walls, taps and fittings, wash basins, sinks with detergent powder and liquid phenyl daily. It will be ensured that toiletries such as liquid soap, naphthalene balls, harpic and napkins are always available. In addition, at least weekly cleaning of stained pottery items shall be done as and when required to keep the things in neat and tidy conditions. Arrangements will also be made for application of room freshener and providing odoniil sticks etc. The contracting agency shall be responsible not only for up keep of the toilets but also for keeping necessary staff to ensure that the common toilets are not misuses.
- Initial sweeping & mopping of all areas shall be completed by 8:00 AM positively every day, failing which monetary penalty shall be imposed and recovered from the contractor's bill
- All waste material including Malba etc. lying in corridors, verandahs, staircases etc. shall be removed and thrown in the dustbin located outside the building premises. It will be the responsibility and duty of the contractor to ensure that there is no water accumulation anywhere inside the premises of the building, especially in the bathrooms/toilets.
- The contractor shall arrange required number of scrubbing machines with moppers or equivalent for scrubbing of floors. These machines should be available on Saturday, Sunday and Holidays and shall be operated on these days. If machines are not available or put in use on the said days a penalty of Rs. 1,000/- per day may be imposed and recovered from the contractor's monthly bills. The decision of the competent authority in this regard shall be final and binding on the contractor and shall not be open to arbitration.
- The floor area adjoining the walls, which may remain un-scrubbed even after using scrubbing machines, are to be cleaned by the contractor by using iron brushes, Carborandum stones and suitable detergents. No extra payment or cost shall be paid on this account
- The contractor himself shall be responsible for the safety and maintenance of his tools and plants materials. No damages/claim of the contractor on this account shall be entertained.
- All the Tools and materials, viz. Scrubbing machine, trolley, buckets, mugs, pipes, ladders etc. shall have to be transported by the contractor himself. The UHS, Rohtak shall not entertain any extra claim/expenditure on account of these tools and materials.
- The sweepers and supervisor shall be under the direct control of the officer in-charge or his/her authorized representative for day-to-day operations.
- The contractor shall supply to his workers all gadgets/articles required for safety purposes, such as gas masks, torch, safety belt, gas lantern etc. He may also maintain a First Aid Box to meet any emergency situation in respect of staff deputed by him.

- The material for daily use like vim powder, liquid soap, Naphthalene balls, Hydrochloric Acid, Odonil balls/stick, fresheners, toilet soap, phenyl, sanitary cubes, toilet paper, tissue paper, Finit, Homocol liquid soap, Harpic, pochha, hand duster, toilet brush, plastic seekh brooms, jail brush, calanzo, platform brush, wiper, soft broms, surf etc. shall be arranged by the Agency for which he has to quote the consolidated amount in the financial bid. The material being used by the agency would be of superior quality/standard and of prominent brands.
- The contractor has to provide all the manpower, equipment's, tools and tackles, their accessories /refills pertaining to sanitation services.
- The contractor has to provide supervisory and management support by his own staff to get the maximum output from the housekeeping force provided to the hospital. Teaching and training for the same has to be done by the contractor. The man and material needed for the management of the sanitary staff will be the responsibility of the contractor.
- Minimum No. of Equipment's, tools tackles etc. to be maintained in the Hospital.

7. The following machines may be required for sanitation services. Wet/ Dry Vacuum Cleaner

- High Pressure Cleaner
- Ladder (24ft and 12 ft)
- Light Duty Machine Scrubber
- Heavy Duty Auto Scrubber dryer
- Steam cleaning machine

Note: - The above mentions machines are minimum requirement. The contractor shall provide brand new machineries as per the details specified in contract and the machines should be ISO Certified. All the above machines including those provided by contractor should be functional all the time.

Scope of Biomedical waste Management Services to be provided by the agency:-

- 1. The agency shall ensure compliance of Biomedical waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 1998 notified by the Government of India and any other rules and guidelines framed by the Haryana Pollution Control Board. The contractor shall be held liable for any contravention/breach of these statutory provisions.
- 2. The agency shall ensure that their supervisory staff and other workers dealing with biomedical waste should be well aware of the provisions contained in the BMW (M&H) Rules, 1998. The contractor shall also arrange frequent training programmes for their staff members for acquainting them with the provisions of this act.
- 3. The agency shall ensure that the biomedical waste is segregated at source by their workers and collected in different colour coded bags according to the waste categories.
- 4. The contractor shall provide all the items required for collection and disposable of biomedical waste:-
- a) Different colour coded poly bags for the collection of biomedical waste at the point of generation
- b) Personal protective kit to waste handlers i.e. gown, goggles, rubber gloves, cap, mask, etc.
- c) The contractor shall provide different colour coded (as per category of Bio medical waste carried by them) waste transportation trolleys for the transportation of waste material from the different departments/ areas to the waste disposable area.
- 5. The contractor shall maintain an adequate stock of the above stated items and in no case these items shall be out of stock.
- 6. The contractor's worker shall label the details on the waste containing poly bags eg. detail of the area where this waste was generated etc. These details will be checked at the point of waste disposal.
- 7. The supervisor should submit an area wise and category wise detail of quantity of waste generated in the O/o Medical Superintendent on weekly basis.
- 8. The contractor shall be liable for the cost of treatment or liabilities (if any) in case of any injury or disease to any waste handler while dealing with biomedical waste.

- 1.2 has the necessary skills, knowledge, expertise, adequate capital and competent personnel, system and procedures, infrastructure and capability to perform its obligations in accordance with the terms of this agreement and to the satisfaction of the UHS, Rohtak;
- 1.3 shall, on the execution of this agreement and providing services to the Department, not violate, breach and contravene any conditions of any agreement entered with any third party/ies;
- 1.4 has compiled with and obtained necessary permissions/licenses/ authorizations under the Central, State and local authorities and obtained all required permissions/licenses for carrying out its obligations under this agreement.

2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE SERVICE PROVIDER

- (a) The Service Provider shall operate and provide services to the Department at its various sites onDays a week fromam. top.m. List of services and the material are as prescribed in Annexure 'II'.
- (b) The regularity of the performance of the service will be the essence of this agreement and shall from a central factor of this agreement. The Service Provider shall take all possible steps to ensure maintain its performance as determined by the Department from time to time.
- (c) The assessment made by the Service Provider in the tender including number of personnel of various descriptions as required to provide/give the required quality of services shall be final and acceptable by and binding upon the Service Provider.
- (d) If the Department notices that the personnel of the Service Provider has/have been negligent, careless in rendering the said services, the same shall be communicated immediately to the Service Provider who will take corrective steps immediately to avoid recurrence of such incidents and reports to the Department.
- (e) If any of the personnel of the Service Provider indulges in theft, negligence or any illegal/irregular activity, misconduct, the Service Provider shall take appropriate action against its erring personnel and intimate accordingly to the Department or itself can take action in accordance with law.
- (f) The Service Provider shall furnish a personal guarantee of its Managing Director/ Partner, guaranteeing the due performance by the Service Provider of its obligations under this agreement.

3. TERMS OF PAYMENT

- (a) Fees and charges for the services to be rendered are at Annexure 'II' as agreed to between the parties.
- (b) All payments made by the Department shall be after deduction of tax at source wherever applicable as per the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- (c) The Service Provider, being the employer in relation to persons engaged/employed by it to provide the services under this agreement shall alone be responsible and liable to pay wages/salaries to such persons which in any case shall not be less than the minimum wages as fixed or prescribed under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Act XI of 1948) for the category of workers employed by it from time to time or by the State Government and /or any authority constituted by or under any law. He will observe compliance of all the relevant labour laws.
- (d) The Service Provider will have to produce the register of wages or the register of wages-cummuster roll of the preceding month along with the bill to be submitted on the 10th day of every calendar month for verification to the nominated official of Department. The Service Provider shall ensure that payment to his employees is made in the presence of an authorized representative of the Department.

4. SUBMISSION AND VERIFICATION OF BILLS

The Service Provider shall submit on a monthly basis the bills for the services enable the Department to verify and process the same.

5. DISCIPLINE

- (a) The service Provider shall issue identity cards, on its own name and trading style, to its personnel deputed for rendering the said services, which at Department's option, and would be subject to verification at any time. The Department may refuse the entry into its premises to any personnel of the Services Provider not bearing such Outsourcing Policy identity card or not being perfectly dressed.
- (b) The Department shall always have the right and liberty to do surprise inspection at its sites.
- (c) The service rendered by the Service Provider under this agreement will be under close supervision, co-ordination and guidance of the Department. The Service Provider shall frame. Appropriate procedure for talking immediate action as may be advised by the Department from time to time.
- (d) It is understood between the parties hereto that the Service Provider alone shall have the right to take disciplinary action against any person(s) to raise any dispute and/or claim whatsoever against the Department. Department shall under no circumstances be deemed or treated as the employer in respect of any person(s) engaged/employed by the Service Provider for any purpose, whatsoever nor would Department be liable for any claim(s) whatsoever, of any such person(s).

6. NATURE OFAGREEMENT

The parties hereto have considered agreed to and have a clear understanding on the following aspects:

- (a) This agreement is on the principal to principal basis and does not create and shall not deem to create any employer-employee relationship between the Department and the Service Provider. The Service Provider shall not by any acts, deeds or otherwise represent any person that the Service Provider is representing 01' acting as agent of Department, except to the extent and purpose permitted herein.
- (b) This agreement is for providing the aforementioned services and is not an agreement for supply of contract labour. It is clearly understood by the Service Provider that the persons employed by the Service Provider for providing services as mentioned herein, shall be the employees of the Service Provider only and not of the Department. The Service Provider shall be liable to make payment to its said employees towards their monthly wages/salaries and/other statutory dues like Employees Provident Fund, Employees State Insurance, minimum wages, bonus, gratuity etc.
- (c) Department shall not be liable for any obligations/responsibilities, contractual, legal or otherwise, towards the Service Provider's employees/agents directly and! Or indirectly, in any manner whatsoever.

7. STATUTORY COMPLIANCES

- (a) Service Provider shall obtain all registration(s)/permission(s)/ license(s) etc. which are/may be required under my labour or other legislation(s) for providing the services under this agreement.
- (b) It shall be the Service Provider's responsibility to ensure compliance of all the Central and State Government Rules and Regulations with regard to the provisions of the services under this agreement. The Service Provider indemnifies and shall always keep Department indemnified against all losses, damages, claims actions taken against Department by any authority/office in this regard.
- (c) The Service Provider undertakes to comply with the applicable provisions of all welfare legislations and more particularly with the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970, if applicable, for carrying out the purpose of this agreement. The Service Provider shall further observe and comply with all Government laws concerning employment of staff employed by the Service Provider and shall duly pay all sums of money to such staff as may be required to be paid under such laws. It is expressly understood that the Service Provider is fully responsible to ascertain and understand the applicability of various Acts, and take necessary action to comply with the requirements of law.
- (d) The Service Provider shall give an undertaking by the 22nd of each month in favour of the Department that he has complied with all his statutory obligations. A draft of the said undertaking is attached herewith as Annexure 'IV' to this agreement.

8. ACCOUNTS AND RECORDS

- (a) The Service Provider shall maintain accurate account and records, statement of all its operations and expenses in connection with its function under this agreement in the manner specified by the Department.
- (b) The service Provider shall forthwith upon being required by the Department, allow Department of any of its authorizes representatives to inspect, audit or take copies of any records maintained by the Service Provider. The Service Provider shall also cooperate in good faith with the Department to correct any practices which are found to be deficient as a result of any such audit within a reasonable time after receipt of the report the Department. However, upon discovery of any discrepancies or under payment the Service Provider shall immediately reimburse the Department for such discrepancies or overcharge.

9. INDEMNIFICATION

- (a) The Service Provider shall at its own expenses make good any loss or damage suffered by the Department as a result of the acts of commission or omission, negligently or otherwise of its personnel while providing the said services at any time of the premises of the Department or otherwise.
- (b) The Service Provider shall at all times Indemnify and keep indemnified that Department against any claim on account of disability/death of any of its personnel caused while providing the services within/outside the site or other premises of the Department which may be made under the workmen's Compensation Act, 1923 or any other Acts or any other Statutory modifications hereof or otherwise for or in respect of any claim for damage or compensation payable in consequence of any accident or injury sustained by the working or there personnel of the Service Provider or in respect of any claim, damage or compensation under labour laws or other laws or rules made thereunder by any Person whether in the employment of the Service Provider or not, who provided or provides the service at the site or any other premises of the Department shall be as provided hereinbefore.
- (c) The Service Provider shall at all times indemnify and keep indemnified the Department Outsourcing Policy against any claim by any third party for any injury, damage to the property or person of the third party or for any other claims whatsoever for any acts of commission or omission of its employees or personnel during the hours of providing the services at the Department's premises or before and after that.
- (d) That, if at any time, during the operation of this agreement or thereafter the Department is made liable in any manner whatsoever by any order, direction or otherwise of any Court authority or tribunal, to pay any amounts whatsoever in respect of or to any of present or expersonnel of the Service Provider or to any third party in any event not restricted but including as mentioned in sub-clauses No (a), (b) and (c) hereinabove, the Service Provider shall immediately pay to the department ,all such amounts and costs also and in all such cases/events the decision of the Department shall be final and binding upon the Service Provider. The department shall be entitled to deduct any such amounts as aforesaid, from the security' deposit and/or from any pending bills of the Service Provider.

10. LIABILITIES AND REMEDIES

In the event of failure of the Service Provider to provide the services or part thereof as mentioned in this agreement for any reasons whatsoever, the Department shall be entitled to procure services from other sources and the Service Provider shall be liable to pay forthwith to the Department the difference of payments made to such other sources, besides damages at double the rate of payment.

11. LOSSES SUFFERED BY SERVICE PROVIDER

The Service Provider shall not claim any damages, costs, charges, expenses, liabilities arising out of performance/non-performance of services, which it may suffer or otherwise incur by reason of any act/omission, negligence, default or error in judgement on part of itself and / or its personnel in rendering or non-rendering the services under this agreement.

12. TERMS

This agreement shall be effective for a period of......years with effect fromuptoand can be extended further for such period and on such terms and conditions as may be deemed fit and proper by the Department.

13. TERMINATION

- (a) Either party can terminate this agreement by giving one month's written notice to the other without assigning any reason and without payment of any compensation thereof. However, the Department shall give only a 24 hours notice of termination of this agreement to the Service Provider when there is a major default in compliance of the terms and conditions of this agreement or the Service Provider has failed to comply with its statutory obligations.
- (b) If Service Provider commits breach of any covenant or any clause of this agreement, Department may send a written notice to Service Provider to rectify such breach within the time limit specified in such notice. In the event Service Provider fails to rectify such breach within the stipulated time, the agreement shall stand terminated and Service Provider shall be liable to Department for losses or damages on account of such breach.
- (c) The Department shall have the right to immediately terminate this agreement if the Service Provider becomes insolvent, ceases its operations, dissolves, files for bankruptcy protection, appoints receivers, or enters into an arrangement for the benefit of creditors.

14. ASSIGNMENT OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement is executed on the basis of the current management structure of the Service Provider. Henceforth, any assessment of this agreement, in part or whole, to any third party without the prior written consent of the Department shall be a ground for termination of this agreement forthwith.

15. COMPOSITION AND ADDRESS OF SERVICE PROVIDER

- (a) The Service Provider shall furnish to the Department all the relevant papers regarding its constitution, names and addresses of the management and other key personnel of the Service Provider and proof of its registration with the concerned Government authorities required for running such a business of Service Provider.
- (b). The Service Provider shall always inform the Department in writing about any change in its address or the names and addresses of its key personnel. Further, the Service Provider shall not change its ownership without prior approval of the Department.

16. SERVICE OF NOTICE

Any notice or other communication required or permitted to be given between the parties under this agreement shall be given in writing at the following address of such other addresses as may be intimated from time to time in writing.

17. CONFIDENTIALITY	

It is understood between the parties hereto that during the course of business relationship, the Service Provider may have access to confidential information of Department and it undertakes that it shall not, without Department's prior written consent, disclose, provide or make available any confidential information in any form to any person or entity or make use of such information. This clause shall survive for a period of 5 years from the date of expiry of this agreement or earlier termination thereof.

18. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This agreement represents the entire agreement, the parties and supersedes all previous or other writing and understandings, oral or written, and further any modifications to this agreement, if required shall only be made in writing.

19. AMENDMENT/MODIFICATION Outsourcing Policy

The parties can amend this agreement at any time. However, such amendment shall be effective only when it is reduced in writing and signed by the authorized representatives of both parties hereto.

20. SEVERABILITY

If, for any reason, a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this agreement, or portion thereof, to be unenforceable, that provision of the agreement will be enforced to the maximum extent permissible so as to effect the intent of the parties, and the remainder of this agreement shall continue in full force and effect.

21. CAPTION

The various captions used in this agreement are for the organizational purpose only and may not be used to interpret the provisions hereof. In case of any conflicts between the captions and the text, the text shall prevail.

22. WAIVER

At any time any indulgence or concession granted by the Department shall not alter or invalidate this agreement nor constitute the waiver of any of the provision hereof after such time, indulgence or concession shall have been granted. Further, the failure of the Department to enforce at any time, any of the provisions of this agreement or to exercise any option which is herein provided for requiring at any time the performance by the Service Provider of any of the provisions hereof, shall in no way be construed to be a waiver of such provisions of this agreement nor in any way affect the validity of this agreement or any part thereof or the right of the Department to enforce the same in part or in the entirety of it. Waiver, if any, has to be in writing.

23. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party shall be in default if a failure to perform any obligation hereunder is caused solely by supervening conditions beyond that party's reasonable control, including acts of God, civil commotion, strikes, acts of terrorism, labour disputes and governmental or public authority's demands or requirements.

24. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

This agreement shall be deemed to have been mode/executed at Rohtak for all purposes. In the event of any dispute related to the interpretation or rights or liabilities arising out of this agreement, the same shall, at first instance, be amicably settled between the parties. If any dispute is not settled amicably, the same shall be referred to the sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Vice Chancellor, UHS, Rohtak. The award given by the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties. The venue of arbitrator shall be Rohtak

25. GOVERNING LAW/JURISDICTION

The applicable law governing this agreement shall be the laws of India and the courts of Rohtak shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to try any dispute with respect to this agreement.

26. All other terms and conditions and clauses given in the tender document will also be a part of this MOU.

27. TWO COUNTERPARTS

This agreement is made in duplicate. The Service Provider shall return a copy of this agreement duly signed and stamped as a token of acceptance of all terms and conditions mentioned above. In the event of commencement of order acceptance, it will be taken that all terms are acceptable.
