**Subject: Admission to UG (MBBS/BDS) courses in the State of
Haryana for the Academic Session 2017-18.**

Kindly refer to the above cited subject.


I have been directed to intimate that in pursuance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 05.07.2017 passed in the WP (C) No. 76 of 2015, the time schedule for counselling and admission in BDS course for the academic year 2017-18 has been issued vide Public Notice dated 25.07.2017 by Dental Council of India. In view of this Public Notice, a final Mop-Up round for BDS course in all the Dental Colleges of the State (Govt./Private) shall be held on 08.09.2017 from 10.00 A.M. onwards and the last date upto which the students can be admitted in BDS course against vacancies arising due to any reason is 10.09.2017.

It is further intimated that to ensure that the students are serious in taking up the seats, the following conditions may be uploaded on the websites of the University of Health Sciences, Rohtak and Admission Portal:-

1. The candidates coming up for Mop-up round shall have to bring their original documents. No candidate without original documents shall be entertained for admission during the Mop-up round.
2. Students seeking admission to MBBS course should bring alongwith, a demand draft of Rs.5 lakh, favouring "Registrar, Pandit Bhagwat Dayal University of Health Sciences, Rohtak" and deposit the same with the Admission Committee at the time of counselling when a seat is allotted to him/her in a private Medical College or a Medical College under Private University. Similarly, students desirous of seeking admission to BDS course shall bring a demand draft of Rs. 2 lakh, favouring "Registrar, Pandit Bhagwat Dayal University of Health Sciences, Rohtak"

and deposit the same with the Admission Committee at the time of counselling when a seat is allotted to him/her in a private Dental College or in a Dental College under Private University. However, a candidate getting admission in a Govt. Medical College or MAMC, Agroha (which is a Govt. aided Institute) or PGIDS, Rohtak shall not be required to deposit this amount at the time of allocation of a seat to him/her. This amount will be adjusted towards annual fee of the Institute where they have been admitted during Mop-up round. In case a student after having taken admission during Mop-up round does not report for admission in the concerned Institute with the balance amount of fee in this round, amount of the Demand Draft shall be forfeited and he/she shall have no claim against the same. The forfeited amount shall be forwarded by the Registrar to the concerned institute where the candidate had been allotted seat during Mop-up-round.

You are requested to upload the above for the information of candidates desirous of seeking admission in MBBS/BDS courses in the Mop-up round on the website of Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak (www.uhsr.ac.in) as well as on the admission web portal (www.uhsugadmissions.in).
