**NOTIFICATION**

**Subject: Stopage of practice of condonation of attendance upto 5% by the Principal/ Head of the Institutions.**

It is for information of all concerned that the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court vide its interim order dated 06.09.2017 in CWP No. 2339 of 2017 (O&M) Madhuri and Ors. V/s Union of India & Ors. and ACSMER dated 25.09.2017 pointed out that any discretion regarding condonation of lectures in a serious professional course like MBBS or BDS which has a direct bearing on the Health of People whom these doctors will be serving in future is highly unwarranted. The University should do away with the provision after making necessary amendment and the University Calendar.

Hence the matter was placed before the Academic Council on 26.04.2018 and Executive Council in its meeting held on 10.05.2018. As per decision taken in meeting of Academic Council and Executive Council, 1<sup>st</sup> provision under sub para 2(ii) of clause 6 of University Ordinance No. 7 for MBBS and clause 6.5 of University Ordinance No. 13 for BDS Course shall be withdrawn after the next University examinations scheduled to be held within next three months. Academic Council/Executive Council further approved the above proposal for all courses being run by the University including its affiliated colleges.

Hence, the practice of condonation of attendance up to 5% by the Principal/Head of the Institution is dispensed with as per the decision of the Academic Council/Executive Council.
