Applications are invited for the following vacant posts of Teachers (Assistant Professors) & GDMO (on regular basis) and Senior Resident-Dental (on Tenure Basis) in Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences and Postgraduate Institute of Dental Sciences, Rohtak, respectively. The Prescribed application form can be downloaded from the website [www.uhsr.ac.in](http://www.uhsr.ac.in) which must be accompanied by a crossed Demand Draft worth Rs. 1000/- for General Category and Rs. 250/- for Reserved Categories (for Haryana Domicile) in favour of the Controller of Finance, Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak. 50% concession in the above fee is granted to the women candidates as per Govt. instructions. PH candidates are exempted from the application fee. Applications, complete in all respects, must reach in the O/O the Asstt. Registrar, Recruitment & Establishment Branch, University of Health Sciences, Rohtak by 15.12.2017 upto 5:00 PM. However, the candidates belonging to remote areas can submit their application forms by 22.12.2017 upto 5:00 PM but the closing date will be considered as 15.12.2017 for all purposes.

**Note:-** As per Govt. instructions no. 22/55/81-3GSIII dated 15.3.1983, where some period of experience is prescribed as an essential qualification for direct recruitment to a post, and sufficient number of persons with the prescribed experience are not available from Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and Handicapped, the experience, qualification shall be relaxable to the extent of 50%. The qualification regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the competent authority in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of selection, the sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

- Doctors, who are working as Sr. Residents/ Demonstrators on tenure basis for a period of one year, should also apply for tenure posts of 3 years.
- Duration: The Duration/Tenure of the above posts is for a maximum period of 3 years only.
- The selected candidates should be prepared to join immediately.

**Terms & Conditions for Teacher (Assistant Professor)**


- Age: - (As on before the last date of submission of applications)- Not less than 25 years or not more than 55 years.
- These posts will be governed by Rules & Regulations of Pt. B.D.Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak Act, 2008/ Haryana Medical Education Service (HMES) Rules, 1988 (amended from time to time)/ HMES (Amendment) Rules, 2007 and as per amendment issued by the Govt. on 29.4.2011.
- Freedom fighters and their children/grand children:- This reservation will be available only if quote reserved for Ex-Servicemen or Backward Classes remains unfilled to that extent due to non-availability of suitable Ex-Serviceman or their dependents or non-availability of suitable applicants from Backward Classes. Overall reservation either from the unfilled vacancies of Ex-Servicemen or from the Backward Classes for Freedom Fighters/ their children/ grand children will remain limited to 2% only. This benefit will be available to all grand children i.e. sons and daughters of sons and daughters (paternal as well as maternal) of the Freedom Fighters.

**GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS :-**

- Date of interview schedule shall be displayed on the website [www.uhsr.ac.in](http://www.uhsr.ac.in). No separate letters will be sent by post, hence the applicants are advised to visit the university website regularly.
- Original documents along with one set of self attested photocopies to be produced at the time of interview:-
  - 10<sup>th</sup> Class Certificate for proof of Date of Birth.
  - Certificate for proof of reservation category, if applicable.
  - MBBS, MD/MS, Post Doctoral Degrees.
  - Attempt certificate during various degree programs.
  - MCI or State Medical Council registration certificate for both MBBS and MD if applicable.
  - Certificate of additional qualifications where applicable.
  - Experience Certificate.
  - Photocopies of the research publications along with copy of proof of indexing status of the journal in which the research article is published.
  - Certificate of presentation of the research article at a conference.
  - Sports certificate for prize or position in an international/national/inter university sports or athletic meet.
  - College Colour Certificate for Sports.
  - Any other certificate.
- Benefit of age relaxation:- Age relaxation of 05 years for SC candidates and 05 years for BC candidates will be given as per Haryana Govt. policy/ instructions issued from time to time and is restricted to Haryana domiciles only. The upper age limit prescribed for appointment to any service or posts shall be relaxed in favour of ex-serviceman to the extent of his military service added by three years provided-
  - (a) He has rendered continuous military service for a period of not less than six months before his release; and
  - (b) He was released otherwise than by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency.
- The applicants who are already in Govt./Semi Govt./Corporation or Autonomous Body Service should send application through their respective Head of Institute or 'No Objection Certificate' may be submitted at the time of interview failing which the applicant will not be allowed/ considered for interview.
- Applicant must also bring all the original documents listed on serial number 2 of the general terms and conditions and one set of self attested photocopies of the said documents. All these should be submitted at the time of interview.



6. Mere submission of the application and call for interview does not mean that the applicant is eligible for the post applied for. The eligibility shall be verified before the interview as per the qualifications, experience and other terms and conditions given in the advertisement.
7. For the posts of Teacher (Assistant Professor- Medical), only the experience gained in a Medical College which is permitted/ recognized by the MCI will be counted towards teaching experience.
8. Details of the Research work/ Publications ( in annotated form) indicating index/ non-index status and Impact Factor of the journal must be submitted at the time of interview. Best five research works along with citations supported by relevant documents must also be furnished at the time of interview. Any other relevant outstanding National/ Inter-national achievements in the profession supported by the documents, if any, must also be supplied.
9. Number of posts is liable to increase or decrease, including complete withdrawal without assigning any reason.
10. The SC/BC-A/ BC-B candidates are required to submit SC/BC certificate duly issued by the competent authority at the time of interview. In addition to the above any other certificate of extracurricular activities (sports) i.e. Prize or position in an international/national/inter-university/ athletic meet and college colour, if any, must also be supplied. ESM/DESM are required to produce the fresh Eligibility Certificate duly issued by the respective Zila Sainik Boards at the time of interview. The candidates applying for PH category should submit certificate issued by the Authorized Medical Board.
11. The posts of reserved categories will be filled up as per Haryana Govt. policy/ instructions applicable/issued from time to time.
12. Three percent of the posts shall be reserved for person disability (PH category) for which only applicants with loco-motor/ orthopedically disability of 40% and above involving one leg (OL) are eligible. A person who wants to avail of the benefit of reservation would have to submit a Disability Certificates issued by a Competent Authority on the prescribed format at Annexure D of Govt. of Haryana, General Administration Department (General Services III Branch) vide its notification No. 22/10/2013-1GSIII dated 15.7.2014.
13. In case any applicant belonging to Scheduled Castes or Backward Classes or any other reserved category applies against General Category post, he/ she must fulfil the conditions of eligibility regarding age/ application fee; etc. as are meant for General Category candidates (as per Govt. instructions).
14. In case any discrepancy is detected in the document submitted by the applicant or in the process of selection, at any stage even after the issue of appointment order, the University reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the applicants.
15. The decision of the appointing authority in all matters relating to acceptance or rejection of application, eligibility/ suitability of the applicants, mode and criteria for selection etc. shall be final and binding on the applicants.
16. All disputes pertaining to the recruitment of various posts shall fall within the jurisdiction of Rohtak only.
17. The prescribed qualification, experience and age limit etc. shall be reckoned as on the closing date of submission of applications.
18. The degrees of undergraduate/ postgraduate/ DM/M.Ch/MDS not recognised by the MCI/DCI shall render the applicant ineligible for the said post.
