The Vice-Chancellor conveyed that the newly developed Trauma Centre has been operationalized w.e.f. 01.01.2018 and dedicated to the society. It was also informed that haemodialysis unit and cathlab facilities are being developed under PPP (Public Private Partnership) mode in the interest of patients.

Following decisions were taken during the meeting after thorough discussions.

1. The minutes of 3rd meeting of IQAC held on **20-11-17** were circulated to all the members and positive remarks were received. In the meeting, once again the comments were invited and minutes were confirmed.
2. Two presentations were made as under:
 - a) Dr. Ishwar Singh, Prof. I/c Trauma Center gave presentation on the newly developed Trauma Center and gave description of facilities available at the Center. The University has 4 storied Trauma Center with 24X 7 services having laboratory facilities, 5 major OTs, 2 minor OTs, Administrative floor, ward, central oxygen supply, suction facility and compressed air facility. The process for Central Air Conditioning of the entire building is nearing completion. The Center has AC waiting hall, 2 ambulances and dedicated parking. Internal audit and patient feed back shall be in place shortly. A separate room shall be developed for medicolgal consultation in Trauma Center. Isolation room shall be developed for dealing victims of sexual assault. All quality parameters shall be practiced and recorded for future reference. Psychosocial support shall be provided for Trauma Center. One 500 KVa generator is already available. Additional power back up system is being procured for un-interrupted power supply (24X 7). Rehabilitation programme shall be in place in Trauma Center. Fire safety system shall be strengthened for Trauma Center including fire van for campus. Weekly mortality meetings shall be conducted in Trauma Center.
 - b) Dr. Veena Singh Ghalaut, Prof. of Biochemistry gave presentation on Quality assurance of laboratories at PGIMS, Rohtak. She emphasised on the quality of reagents, man power, machines and samples. Such practice shall result in right report at right time. Internal and external quality checks are already in place.
3. Dr. Sukhdev Chandla, Prof. Incharge I.T. informed that around 80% work of online registration of patients is complete. Online registration for Lab. tests shall also be in place, shortly. Online hospital management systems and Pharmacy software shall be made functional shortly. The 3rd presentation that was to be made by Prof. Pradeep Garg regarding development of e-library facility was postponed to next meeting because of paucity of time.
4. Online dynamic directory of alumni associations of respective colleges will be developed. Rs.500/- shall be deducted from the security at the time of leaving the institute to develop corpus for respective alumni associations.

It was also decided that the next meeting of IQAC shall be scheduled in Feb., 2018 so that AQAR shall be submitted for first year on time.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to chair.
