The dates of examinations are decided before planning any other activity on campus. Internal evaluation for the under graduate students is scheduled during the appropriate time slots so as to provide full opportunity to students for their comprehensive studies. University has designed protocols for oral and overall performance appraisal of the students for subjects which require practical examination. Students are evaluated through oral examination and by their punctuality throughout the year determined based on their practical records.

If the students are unable to attend the examination due to sports or some other activities or fail in the concerned subjects, the University conducts supplementary examination appropriately so that the deserving students are not lagged behind. Semester-based courses in the University are dealt appropriately as the examinations are to be conducted every six months. In case of Post-Graduate (PG) courses having annual system or semester system are programmed appropriately so that studies of one programme do not suffer due to other programmes. Continuous evaluation is done by the faculty members at micro level through various activities such as solution preparation test, seminar(s) quiz competition, group discussion, surprise test, article reviews, assignment(s) and mid-term tests carried out during semester.
