- The Department of Anaesthesiology, PGIMS Rohtak plays a key role in providing healthcare facilities of our hospital. The Department of Anaesthesiology is one of the largest Departments of PGIMS presently comprising of 52 consultant/ faculty members, 11 S.R. and 124 PG students.

a. PCOS Research & Screening Centre in MRU and PCOS CLINIC at Pt. B. D. Sharma PGIMS, Rohtak

- I. To start PCOS research and screening centre in MRU, Pt BDS PGIMS, Rohtak
- II. Multidisciplinary team for conducting research in clinical, epidemiological and genetic aspects of PCOS and preparing repositories and database and serve as research and screening centre for proposed Clinic for PCOS.
- III. To address most concerns of women with PCOS and will serve as a platform where services and research would meet.
- IV. Multidisciplinary team of Obstetrics and Gynecology (infertility specialist), dermatologist, psychiatrist, nutritionist and yoga expert will provide holistic management to women with PCOS.
- V. Also, Community Medicine, Endocrinology Dept., Institute of Mental Health, Dermatology department and College of Nursing in Community nursing or nursing psychiatry would be part of the team..

b. Multi-MRU-ICMR Project:

- I. Title: Prevalence of germline EGFR T790M mutation in India: A nationwide cross-sectional survey of newly diagnosed non-small cell lung carcinoma patients
- II. Objectives: Assess the prevalence of germline EGFR mutations in patients with lung cancer
- III. Outcomes: We expect to understand the prevalence of germline EGFR mutations and its contribution to lung cancer. The data will aid in designing genetic screening programs for early diagnosis of lung cancer. The inclusion of patients from across the country will aid in understanding regional genetic variations and possibly founder effects. In future, we may be able to expand testing on relatives of patients and volunteers with germline mutations in order to decipher syndromic associations. The DNA of lung cancer patients with germline mutations will be banked for whole exome sequencing analysis. This project will also enable strengthening of the MRUs for molecular testing and promote submission of independent extra-mural project proposals from each MRU.

 - Total 10766 No. of blood units / blood component were issued to Blood Storage Center in Dhanwantri Apex Trauma Care Center for trauma patients in 2019.
 - Eighty One units Single Donor Platelets were prepared in 2019 for dengue & other bleeding disorder patients.
 - Deptt. celebrated World Blood Donor Day (14 June) and felicitated the various social & religious organizations for their contribution in the field of blood donation. Hon'ble the

Vice Chancellor Dr. O.P. Kalra felicitated the organisations of voluntary blood donation.

- Deptt. has been enrolled in Hemovigilance programme of India.
- Dr. Gajender Singh, Prof. & Head & Programme Coordinator of Youth Red Cross Pt B.D.S. UHS, Rohtak received the merit certificate and Youth Red Cross Award from Honourable Governor Sh. Satya Dev Narayan on dated 30 August 2019.
- As a part of International Immunology Day Celebration, Department jointly with Immunohematology & Blood Transfusion Department, PGIMS organized an Outreach Activity- Know Your Blood Group at Central School Rohtak on April 29, 2019. Children were taught about Basics of Immunology and were demonstrated “Antigen-Antibody interaction”. Prof. D.R. Arora, former Head, Department of Microbiology, PGIMS Rohtak was chief guest at this occasion. Dr. Himanshu Raikwar, Assistant Professor delivered a talk for the students where he taught students about ways and means of boosting body’s immunity.
- PHARMACY: 18 students of the institute qualified the national level exam GPAT (Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test); this signifies the hard work of students as well as faculty members. The equipments procured by the institute during the session 2019-20 are Fluorescence Microscope, Stereozoom Microscope, and Rheometer. These are beneficial for UG, PG students and research work.
- PHARMACOLOGY: The department actively conducted online teaching for various undergraduate and postgraduate courses.
- An E-poster Competition for undergraduate students on “Antimicrobial awareness” was organized by Department of Pharmacology, PGIMS, Rohtak on 23rd November, 2020 under the auspices of ‘World Antimicrobial Awareness Week, 2020’ by WHO with the aim to improve awareness and understanding of antimicrobial resistance and to encourage best practices among undergraduates from an early stage.

- An Event-Driven Phase 3 Randomized, Double-blind, Placebo-controlled, Multicenter Study to Evaluate the Efficacy, Safety, Immunogenicity and Lot-to-Lot consistency of BBV152, a Whole-virion Inactivated SARS-CoV-2 Vaccine in Adults ≥ 18 Years of Age.
