
3. The payment of grant-in-aid will be further subject to the Rule 228 to 245 of provisions of GFR-2017/DFPR-1978/Receipt and Payment Rules 1983(as amended from time to time) and the following terms and conditions.
- (a) The institute shall not without prior sanction of Government dispose of or encumber or utilize the assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the Govt. grant for the purpose other than those for which the grant has been sanctioned.
 - (b) The institute shall maintain separate accounts for the funds received and expenditure incurred under the said project.
 - (c) Accounts of the institute shall be subject to audit as per the audit mechanism existing in the institute. The accounts of the institute shall also be open for test check by the C&AG at its discretion.




This is with reference to the multistate costing study "Costing of Healthcare Services in India" initiated by Health Technology Assessment India (HTAI) under Department of Health Research (DHR), Ministry of Health and Family welfare (MoHFW) which is to be carried out in the State of Haryana under your supervision in Phase 2. As discussed in the Investigators Meeting on 'Costing of Health Services' held in DHR on 1-2 May 2019, you are requested to collect cost data information from public hospitals as part of Phase 2 work in departments-

1. Neurosurgery
2. Burns Management
3. Mental disorders
4. Microbiology

The Micro costing study recommended for this requires information on details of personnel employed (gross salary of personnel, leave availed during last financial year, allowances/incentives received by personnel), physical infrastructure information of the healthcare centre costed, services delivered, utility, overhead information and also information (from ICU, operation theatre, Out Patient Department and Ward wherever applicable) on equipment, consumables, non-consumables and stationary [from the respective ICU, OT, OPD, Ward stock registers and indents from the medical, surgical, stationary and general stores wherever applicable] and time allocation interviews from personnel undertaking multiple duties.

I would appreciate if you could take necessary action possible in this direction which would enable the Phase 2 costing work in the public hospitals, thus providing evidence based information for the designing of cost of different disease packages and help in moving a step forward in realizing Government of India's UHC agenda.







Madam/Sir,

I am directed to say that the project titled "Costing Studies for Health Care Systems under Health Technology Assessment" to be carried out at the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak, Haryana has been approved for funding by Deptt. of Health Research, M/o Health and Family Welfare. 2. State Investigator: Dr. Simmi Kharb. She shall be responsible to carry out the project.

An undertaking would be furnished by the host institution that the staff will be engaged for the project purely on contractual basis and would have no claim to a permanent employment with the DHR. 
- viii. The register of assets maintained by the Institute shall be made available for scrutiny by the Audit.
 - ix. A utilization certificate in proforma prescribed (GFR 12-A) and the audited statement of accounts should be furnished to the DHR to enable the Government to satisfy themselves that the amount has been utilized for the purpose for which it was sanctioned. These documents should be sent to the DHR immediately after the closure of the current financial year and in any case not later than the end of the third month of the next financial year. (format enclosed)
 - x. The accounts of the grantee institution shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit both by the CAG of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act, 1971 and internal Audit Wing of the O/o CCA of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, whenever the institution of organization is called upon to do so.
 - xi. Grantee/institution receiving the grant shall furnish Achievement-cum performance report (final) two months' prior of the scheduled period of the project.
 - xii. Utilization of Travel Grant, Contingency Grant, etc would be as per the extant Guidelines.
 - xiii. Any change in sanctioned budget /salary component/ staff or any component of the approved project will not be entertained.
 - xiv. All interests or other earnings against the grant released by this Department shall be mandatorily remitted to the DHR after finalisation of the accounts.

- IV. The host Institute would be required to submit an annual progress report and also give audited statement of expenditure by the Auditor of the research Organization/Institute etc. However, the first progress report should be submitted at least three months prior to the completion of the annual report.
