

SPEAKING ORDERS

In compliance of Hon'ble High Court's orders in the CWP No. 27004 of 2019 titled Naresh and others V/s State of Haryana and Others

Whereas, a Writ Petition (CWP No. 27004 of 2019) has been filed by Lab Technicians working in BPSGMCW, Khanpur Kalan, Sonapat for issuing of Experience Certificate and further requested not to declare the result for the post of Lab Technician advertised by Pt. B. D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak vide Advt. No. 02/2019 as they have applied for the said post.


Whereas, the above stated writ was disposed-off on 27.09.2019 by the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court at notice stage by passing the following orders :-

"...present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned respondent to decide the representation by passing a well reasoned and speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case representation is not decided within aforementioned specified time, there shall be costs of Rs.25000/- to be paid by the concerned officer to the petitioners."

Whereas, the claim of the petitioners in the writ petition was that all the petitioners have been working as Lab Technician for past many years and some of them have been working since 2012 in BPSGMCW, Khanpur Kalan, Sonapat and they have applied for the post of Lab Technician advertised by the University vide Advt. No.02/2019. The petitioners requested the authorities of BPSGMCW, Khanpur Kalan, Sonapat to issue them experience certificates as the same had to be produced in University, but the same was not issued by the College, so they filed the writ with a pray to direct the BPSGMCW, Khanpur Kaian, Sonapat to issue them experience certificates.

Whereas the brief background to the lis, is that Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak had advertised various non-teaching posts vide Advt. No. 02/2019 including 71 posts of Lab Technician with the following qualifications:

- i) B.Sc. in Medical Laboratory Technology (BMLT) from a recognized Institute/ University.
- ii) Hindi/Sanskrit up to Matric Standard.

As per selection criteria, a Written/Screening Test was conducted on 18.08.2019 for the posts of Lab Technicians and Operation Theatre Technicians. As per General Terms & Conditions of the advertisement, after the declaration of result of written test the category-wise candidates were called on 31.08.2019 and 01.09.2019, in the ratio of 1:3 (where the vacancies in any category are two or more) and in the ratio of 1:5 (where the vacancy in any category is only one), for verification of their original documents and for awarding of maximum 10 marks as per the socio-economic and experience criteria fixed by the State Govt. The merit list for the selection of Lab Technicians has been approved by the Establishment Committee in its meeting held on 07.09.2019 and also approved by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor but the result has not been declared due to pendency of a representation with the State Govt.

The matter of issuing of experience certificates pertain to BPS Govt. Medical College for Women, Kanpur Kalan, Sonapat as all the petitioners are working as Lab Technicians in BPS Govt. Medical College for Women. Hence, the action on this representation is to be taken by the BPS Govt. Medical College for Women, Kanpur Kalan, Sonapat not by the Pt. B.D. Sharma, University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.
