At the outset, the Vice-Chancellor extended a warm welcome to all the members present. Thereafter, with the permission of the Chair, the Registrar began the proceedings of the Executive Council. The following agenda item was then taken up for consideration by the Executive Council: -

AGENDA ITEM NO.56.01

TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE / CONFIRM THE ACTION TAKEN BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR REGARDING REVISION OF VARIOUS AFFILIATION FEES FROM THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2026-27

As per Clause 29 of the University Ordinance "*Conditions of Affiliation of Colleges and Institutions to the Privileges of the University and Withdrawal of Such Privileges*", the affiliation fees are to be revised from time to time by the Executive Council. As per records, the continuation affiliation fee has not been revised since 2012, and the provisional affiliation fee has not been revised since 2017. Thus, more than ten years have elapsed since the last revision of the continuation fee.

It is pertinent to mention here that during the academic session 2013-14, approx 70 Colleges were affiliated with this University. The number has since increased to 160 Colleges up to the academic session 2024-25 along with multiple courses/streams i.e. Medical/Dental/MD/MS/Physiotherapy/Pharmacy/Nursing etc. This significant increase has substantially enhanced the workload related to the affiliation process, which includes constitution of inspection committees, conduct of inspections, removal of deficiencies pointed out by inspection teams, re-inspections, and redressal of multiple complaints received

from students and the general public. These activities have resulted in considerable financial burden and increased utilization of manpower.

There is lot of expenses of the University regarding inspections such as providing transport facilities to members of assessment team, providing videography services to assessment team etc. All these expenses are borne by the University.

Further, on perusal of the fee structures of other State Health Universities such as Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur; Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot (Punjab); Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University, Uttar Pradesh; and other Health Universities including Maharashtra Health University, Odisha Health University, and Kerala University of Health Sciences, it has been observed that these Universities levy various additional charges such as Endowment Fund, Pledge Money, Security Fee, and Administrative and Service Charges (annual and/or one-time). In contrast, Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak charges only Application Processing Fee and Provisional Affiliation Fee (one-time), along with Continuation Fee and Inspection Fee (annual), which are comparatively much lower. A comparative chart is enclosed as **Annexure-56.01/A** for kind perusal.

In view of the above, a Committee was constituted by the Vice-Chancellor under the Chairmanship of the Registrar to examine and make recommendations regarding revision/enhancement of various affiliation fees, namely Processing Fee, Affiliation Fee, Continuation Fee and Inspection Fee. The Committee met on 27.11.2025 and its recommendations are placed at **Annexure-56.01/B**.

The recommendations of the Committee were placed before the Vice-Chancellor and after approval, a notification was issued and circulated to all affiliated colleges of Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak, in anticipation of approval of the Executive Council, vide Endst. No. UHSR/Affiliation/2025/4764-4934 dated 09.12.2025 (**Annexure-56.01/C**).

Subsequently, representations were received from various colleges regarding the revised fee structure and extension of the date for submission of Continuation Affiliation Fee and Inspection Fee for the academic session 2026-27. These representations were placed before the Vice-Chancellor and after consideration, the last date was extended for submission of the said fees from 31.12.2025 to 15.01.2026, applicable only for the academic session 2026-27 for Pharmacy Institutions. The Vice-Chancellor also directed the same Committee to re-examine the matter.

Accordingly, the Committee met again on 01.01.2026 to review the revised fee structure notified vide letter dated 09.12.2025. The opinion of the Committee is placed at **Annexure-56.01/D**. The same was placed before the Vice-Chancellor and after approval, a revised notification was issued and circulated to all affiliated colleges vide Endst. No. UHSR/Affiliation/2026/294-458 dated 09.01.2026 (**Annexure-56.01/E**).

Hence, the matter was placed before the Executive Council for consideration and approval/ confirmation of the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor.

Proceeding of EC:-

At the outset, the Registrar placed the agenda before the Executive Council and presented all relevant facts along with comparative data regarding the revision in various affiliation and inspection fees applicable to the affiliated colleges of the University.

Thereafter, Dr. Rajiv Gupta, Dean Faculty of Medicine & Allied Deptts; Dr. Sanjay Tiwari, Principal, PGIDS; and Dr. M.K. Garg, Director, KCGMC, Karnal, presented their views in support of the revision of fees notified by the University.

Subsequently, Dr. I.K. Pandit, Principal, J.N. Kapoor DAV Dental College, Yamunanagar, requested that since the maximum intake in dental colleges of Haryana is 100; hence the various fees applicable to dental colleges may be reviewed and re-fixed in slabs of 50 and 100 seats.

Dr. Sheeba Mohindra, Government Representative, conveyed that any recommendation regarding enhancement of fees approved by the Executive Council may be forwarded to the Government for consideration and approval.

It was further conveyed that the number of seats in Paramedical Courses is comparatively very low. Therefore, such courses running in the existing affiliated colleges may be treated as a single unit and a single consolidated fee may be charged instead of levying separate course-wise fees.

It was also categorically stated that a substantial expenditure is incurred by the University on inspections of affiliated colleges conducted from time to time either for itself or on behalf of the Government. Accordingly, the revision in these fees is fully justified to meet the expenditure of the University. It was further observed that private Medical, Dental, Pharmacy, and Nursing colleges charge substantial fees from students every year, and the fees revised by the University is comparatively meager.

After detailed deliberations and careful consideration of all facts and documents placed before it, the Executive Council unanimously resolved as under:

The Executive Council confirmed and approved the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor regarding revision in fees as notified by the University vide Notification dated 09.12.2025 and 09.01.2026, with the following modifications/amendments:

- (a) For Dental Colleges, the slabs shall be substituted against item (i)4(a) (Continuation Fee) for BDS Course as under:
 - Up to 50 seats: ₹8.00 lakh
 - Up to 100 seats: ₹12.00 lakh
- (b) Paramedical Courses running in the existing affiliated colleges shall be treated as one unit, and a single consolidated fee shall be charged accordingly.
